

Approach Control Surveillance Course

Course Aim

The course is designed to equip participants with the behavioural strategies, positive safety attitude, and non-technical skills required to make the most effective use of available resources to minimize the occurrence and mitigate the systemic impact of teamwork-related errors in accordance with national and international standards.

- Air Traffic Controllers, Engineers (ATSEPs) and Aeronautical Information Officers
- Meteorological (MET) Observers / Briefing personnel
- Managers and Supervisors of Civil Aviation Authorities (CAA) and Air Navigation Service Providers (ANSP)

Entry Requirements

- Minimum Age: 21 years
- Background in Air Traffic Control, Engineering and Aeronautical Information services, Meteorology, Civil Aviation Authorities (CAA) and Air Navigation Service Providers (ANSP)
