

Dangerous Goods Regulations for Personnel Responsible for Processing or Accepting Goods Presented as General Cargo-Initial

Course Aim

The course is designed to prevent undeclared dangerous goods from being accepted into air transport and loaded on an aircraft to comply with the applicable provisions of the regulations and to be suitable condition for air transport in accordance with IATA Dangerous Goods Regulations Manual and ICAO Doc 9284 – Technical Instructions for the Safe Transport of Dangerous Goods by Air

Who should attend

Personnel responsible for processing, handling, documenting, inspecting, or accepting dangerous goods consignments for air transport, including freight forwarders, ground handling agents or operators

Entry Requirements

- Minimum age:18 years
- Holder of successful Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE)
- Ability to communicate effectively in English
